

## COVID MINISTRY AFTERMATH

Greetings from the Montaño family! Great news from Hermosillo, Sonora. We hope that all of our supporting churches had a fruitful season of ministry!

I want to first thank everyone and their commitment to missions even through the difficulties of COVID. We as a family appreciate and value your faithfulness. As you know from our July update, because of Covid we could no longer make rent payments on our building. We had to let them go. We found another building that we could make payments on. It is the same owner so God blessed us with time to transition. Many of the things we went through, although discouraging at times, were blessings in disguise. The building we are moving to is bigger than our old building, and for almost half the price. Right now we are going through construction pains as we try to fix a very old building and make it a new church home.

Three weeks ago we started to meet at Church at 25% capacity. We have had visitors come in the last weeks and a few saved. We have also opened a Christian school. We are introducing 'homeschool at church 'to help young people receive a Christian education. We ask your prayers - it is a lot

of work and also a great responsibility. My wife is in charge of that ministry. We have twenty students.

This month we started our institute classes again. Please continue to pray we can prepare more laborers for the fields. In the midst of this we have a couple from our church that will be planting a new church in a city a couple of hours from Hermosillo. I lead Daniel to Christ eight years ago. He surrendered his life, went to Bible college, graduated and is now preparing to raise funds to start a new church!! I know that blesses your heart since you have a part in everything.

Our family as of now is healthy, we push forward anyway we can to minister for the Lord's sake.
