The day after Christmas I received a call from one of his friends that Darren had attempted to take his own life. I was able to talk with Darren and encouraged him to come to our home. We were able to keep him for 2 nights and encourage him to do right. We shared verses with him and prayed for him, but he felt the draw of the world and returned to the old life he was saved from. He waited until Dawn and I were out to leave. Later that night I received a text which said, "with tears I left and went right back to the old life." Please pray for Darren.

Dawn and I have been doing discipleship and Bible studies with various ones in the Church. It is always encouraging to see a believer take a step of growth in their life. God always gives us what we need to encourage us to keep on keeping on for Him. We know as well that we have a number of prayer warriors around the world who pray for us and that prayer is greatly appreciated.

Our future team members are currently on deputation and are near 50% of their needed support. We are looking forward to having Logan and Brittany Bankston and their children here in New Zealand. Our plan is to wait until they arrive here and get settled in before taking a furlough. Prayers for their family would be appreciated as well.
